## Opengraph

Open Graph objects are annotated web pages with a set of tags which provide the property value. The properties on an object include the title, description, and any custom properties. Objects are connected to users via actions, and when this happens, an object will appear in Timeline, News Feed and Ticker.

## **Opengraph : the simple version**

It's about the **connections** between things.



### **Opengraph : the complicated version**

It's a <u>catalog</u> of all existing things—and some that don't exist—and the relationships between them.

• Everything in the opengraph has an ID number

  - You can write connections

## What can they do? (the short list)

Pages are public.
Anyone can like a page
But you can block them
Page administrators can:
Invite friends
Post status updates
Use a like box (on your website)
Promote with ads
View statistics
...and more.

How are page administrators declared in Opengraph meta tags?
fb:admins (Opengraph ids)
fb:app\_id (Opengraph id)

# What is a Facebook app?

#### an API key.

a Facebook "canvas" that displays your content in an iFrame in the context of Facebook.

## What do they do?

Manage their own pages, streams, etc.

these can be used to communicate with subscribers through their news feeds, tickers, etc.

Define custom Opengraph objects & connections

- Manage user accounts on your website
  your user accounts can be linked to their facebook accounts
- Manage fb users' data (if they authorize you)

Obtain data about users and friends, such as events, groups, photos, videos, likes, location, birthday, hometown, checkins, etc. Read their mail

Create and manage events as that user

- Read their notifications and mark them as read
- Publish actions to their stream

Communicate with them via SMS

Masquerade as and manage their pages

## Login through Facebook

• Not always a login to Drupal! Login through Facebook authorizes your app. It does not necessarily login to Drupal, as some of Facebook's docmentation suggests. May login to Drupal, and May create a Drupal user if you set it up.



## Canvas / Page Tab

 "App on Facebook" will let you build a dynamic web page and then display it on in an iFrame as a Facebook page.

"Page Tab" will let you build a dynamic web page and then display it (in an iFrame) as a tab that *many people* can put on their Facebook pages.

 Your dynamic web page can be written in any language that accepts post requests, like PHP.

## **Social Plugins**

The fb\_social module
extremely intuitive configuration
most social plugins supported
does not let your app use or publish Facebook data

#### - Or -

The fb (drupal for facebook) module
configured with XFBML / HTML5 code
some coding needed for most plugins
all social plugins supported
lets your app use or publish Facebook data
On your own, with the SDKs
...good luck.

## **Opengraph tags**

Metatag

- basic opengraph tags
- works on at least nodes, terms, users
  - token replacements
  - VERY intuitive and clean
- Auto Opengraph
  - all documented opengraph tags
  - works on all viewable entities
  - token replacement
  - image resizing
  - clunky and messy
  - will likely be obsolete when Metatag matures
  - Opengraph Metabasic opengraph tags

    - works on nodes
    - entered on a per-node basis

## **Facebook Pages**

• For initial support, implement Opengraph • If you want to publish to a page manually, implement the fb:admins tag • Try RSS Graffiti (the facebook app) https://www.facebook.com/RSS.Graffiti for sites with a small number of pages Otherwise, custom programming is required for: publishing to a page's feed tracking opengraph id for pages notifying facebook users about comments etc.

## **Facebook Apps**

Create the app
http://developers.facebook.com/apps

#### Drupal for Facebook (fb)

- manage Drupal users
   with Facebook
- use custom Opengraph actions
- interact with Facebook data directly
- AND anything else

#### Facebook Social (fb\_social)

let site visitors promote your site on Facebook
give site visitors social context for your pages (what their friends did)

## **Directions for development\***

- Solid framework for opengraph meta tags
  metatag module will probably cover this
  Tracking and managing opengraph objects
  publish Drupal comments to FB object stream
  publish new Organic Groups posts to the FB object stream for the group
  Views : Opengraph API / FQL as a data source
  - fields: fb comments, fb likes, fb friends, etc.
